# LESSON# 1: PROPHETIC GIFT ASPIRATION STAGE

#### **TALKING POINTS**

If you resonate with these signs, it might indicate a God-given longing for the prophetic gift!

According to 1 Corinthians 14:1, the desire for the gift of prophecy can manifest in several ways:

- Hunger for Truth: You may find yourself longing for deeper understanding and insight into God's Word.
- Passion for Others: A strong desire to encourage, comfort, and edify others through prophetic words may emerge.
- Increased Prayer: You might feel drawn to pray more earnestly, seeking guidance and wisdom from the Holy Spirit.
- Seeking Spiritual Growth: A desire for spiritual maturity and a hunger to grow in your faith can indicate a readiness for this gift.
- Listening to the Spirit: You may become more attentive to the Holy Spirit's promptings in your life and the lives of others.
- Confirmation from Others: You might receive encouragement and affirmation from mature Christians about your potential in prophecy.
- Engagement in Community: You may feel led to participate more actively in your church community, seeking opportunities to share insights or messages.
- Biblical Reflection: An inclination to reflect on scriptures related to prophecy can be a sign of your growing desire.

# LESSON# 2: PROPHETIC GIFT MANIFESTATION STAGE

#### **TALKING POINTS**

Experiencing these signs may indicate that you are entering into a phase of developing the prophetic gift in your life!

In Acts 2:4, the emergence of the gift of prophecy can be observed through various signs, including:

- Increased Boldness: A newfound courage to speak about your faith and share God's messages with others.
- Spontaneous Revelation: Experiences of receiving insights or revelations spontaneously during prayer or worship.
- Joy in Sharing: A deep sense of joy and fulfillment when you speak words of encouragement or truth to others.
- Deepened Worship: An intensified worship experience where you feel connected to the Holy Spirit in a powerful way.
- Desire to Share: A strong urge to convey what God is revealing to you, whether through testimony or prophetic insights.
- Visions or Dreams: Occurrences of visions or dreams that carry significant meaning or messages from God for yourself or others.
- Clarity in Communication: A sense of clarity and specificity in the words you feel prompted to share.
- Sensitivity to the Spirit: Heightened sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading during discussions or prayer, prompting you to speak.

- -6-8 Yes: You appear to be in the emerging stage of the prophetic gift! Embrace this journey and continue to seek God's wisdom and direction as you develop your gift.



# LESSON# 3: PROPHETIC GIFT PROGRESSION STAGE

#### **TALKING POINTS**

If you resonate with these signs, it may indicate that your prophetic gift is in a developing stage, and you're growing in its expression!

According to 1 Timothy 4:14-15, signs of being in the developing stage for the gift of prophecy may include:

- Practice and Use of Gifts: Actively exercising and practicing your prophetic gift, sharing insights in various settings.
- Consistent Study: A commitment to studying scripture and prophetic teachings to deepen your understanding and refine your abilities.
- Mentorship: Seeking guidance or mentoring from mature prophetic leaders who can provide insight and feedback on your gift.
- Feedback and Refinement: Receiving constructive feedback from trusted individuals about your prophetic messages, allowing for growth.
- Increased Confidence: Growing confidence in your ability to hear and communicate God's messages, despite initial doubts.
- Desire for Character Growth: A longing to grow in holiness and character, recognizing that personal integrity strengthens prophetic effectiveness.

# LESSON# 4: PROPHETIC GIFT EXAMINATION STAGE

#### **TALKING POINTS**

Experiencing these signs can indicate that you are in the testing stage of developing your prophetic gift, as you seek to navigate the complexities of sharing God's messages!

In Acts 9:28-30, the testing stage for the gift of prophecy may be indicated by several signs:

- Public Ministry: Engaging in public speaking or ministry opportunities where you share prophetic insights with others.
- Facing Opposition: Encountering resistance or skepticism about your prophetic words, similar to how Saul faced challenges in his ministry.
- Discernment from Others: Receiving input and discernment from fellow believers regarding your messages, helping you to refine what you share.
- Evaluation of Messages: Actively seeking to evaluate the accuracy and relevance of your prophetic words through prayer and scripture.
- Accountability: Establishing relationships with mature Christians who hold you accountable for what you share and how you interpret prophetic messages.

- Humility in Sharing: Maintaining humility when sharing prophetic words, recognizing that they must be weighed and tested by the community.

- -0-4 Yes: You might still be in the early stages of discovering your prophetic gift, or not fully engaging in the testing process. Consider seeking guidance and community support.



### LESSON# 5: PROPHETIC GIFT MATURATION STAGE

#### **TALKING POINTS**

These signs suggest that you are maturing in your prophetic gift, growing in both understanding and effectiveness as you seek to serve others in love and truth!

In 1 Corinthians 14:20, the maturing stage for the gift of prophecy can be characterized by several signs:

- Deep Understanding: A matured understanding of God's word and the prophetic context, allowing for depth in your messages.
- Clarity and Precision: Greater clarity and precision in communicating prophetic insights, ensuring your messages are understandable and relevant.
- Balanced Perspective: A balanced approach towards prophecies, combining passion with wisdom, reflecting spiritual maturity.
- Encouragement of Others: Actively using your gift to edify, encourage, and comfort others within the community, similar to the goal of prophecy in 1 Corinthians 14.
- Discernment of Spirit: Enhanced ability to discern the Spirit's leading, distinguishing between your thoughts and genuine prophetic messages.
